SOUNDS LIKE...

- 1. Cut out the animal squares and paste them on the 4 visible sides of a cube-shaped tissue box.
- 2. With your piano student, discuss how different sounds on the piano can represent each animal.
- 3. Snail = Slow, Sheep = Soft, Bunny = Fast, Elephant = Loud).
- 4. Place the tissue box on the piano with an animal square facing your piano student.
- Instruct your piano student to begin playing a piano piece in the style of that animal.
- 6. While your student is playing, rotate the tissue box to reveal a different animal.
- 7. Instruct your student to change the playing style (on the fly) as the tissue box is rotated.
