### TRUE OR FALSE

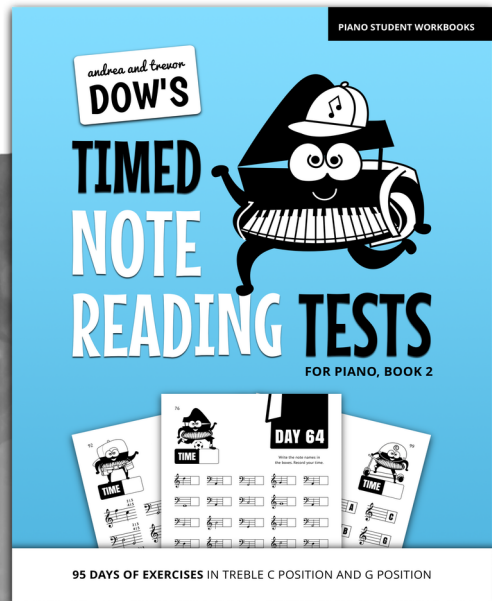
If the note inside a heart matches the note name on the head of the arrow, color the heart red. If the note inside a heart does not match the note name on the head of the arrow, color the heart green.
