BLOCK 2 BLOCK

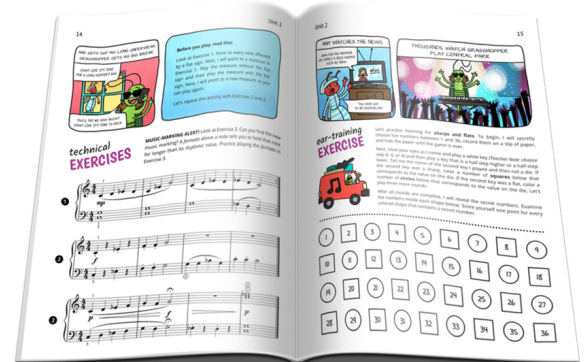


- 1 Can you help the snowman retrieve his hat?

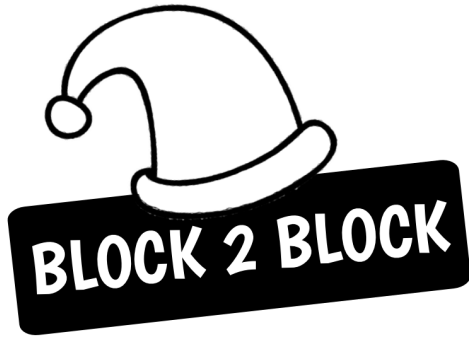
