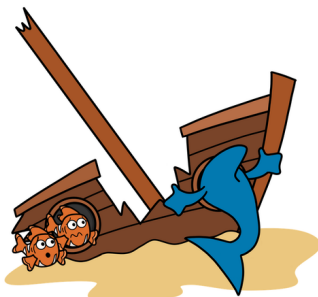





Use today's board game to reinforce C position note reading on the bass staff.

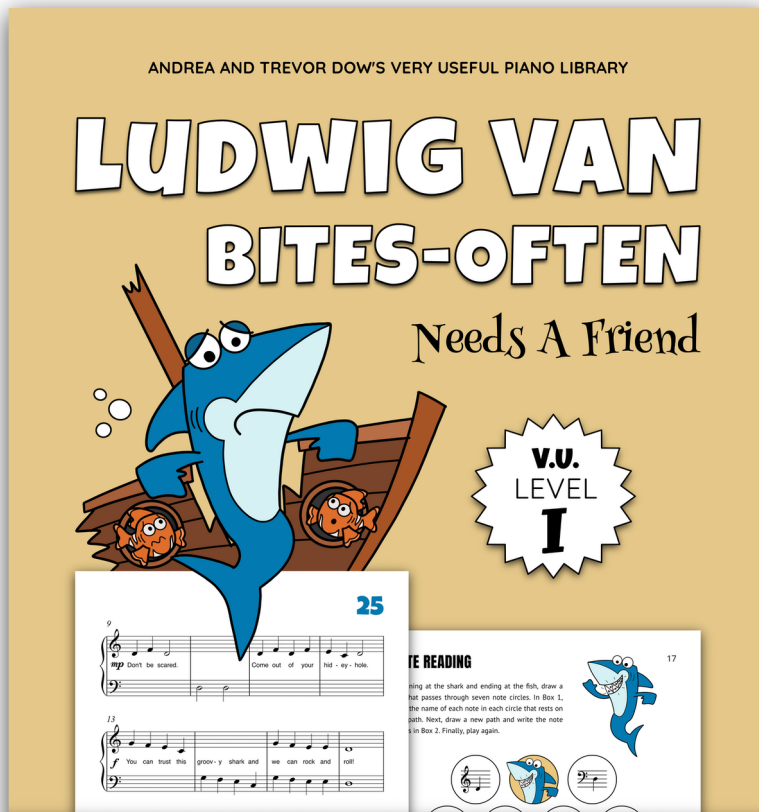




SHARK MUSIC

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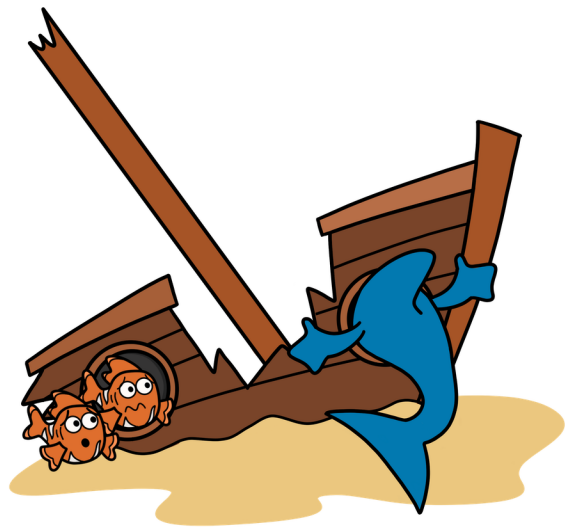
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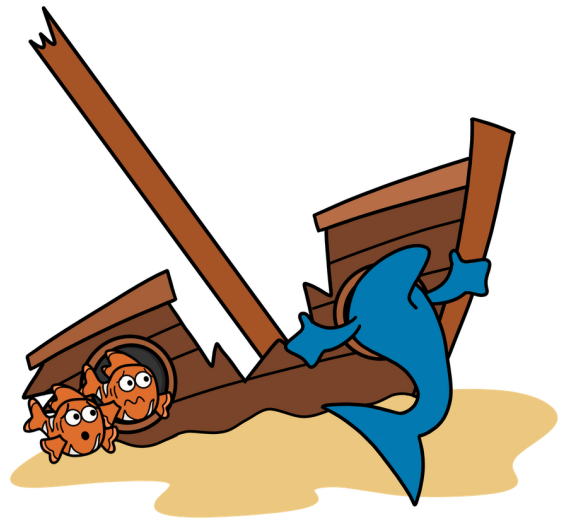

1. To begin, the student places one penny (a “fish”) over each beige game square on the game board.
2. Next, the student chooses a penny, names the note underneath, and then slides the penny along the game squares that contain the matching note. The penny cannot skip over any game squares or move diagonal. For example, if a penny is resting on F on the bass staff, the student slides it from F to F to F.
3. Once the student slides the penny onto a square with a black arrow, it is removed from the game board and the “fish” is safe.
4. The student repeats Steps 3 and 4 for the remaining pennies on the game board.
