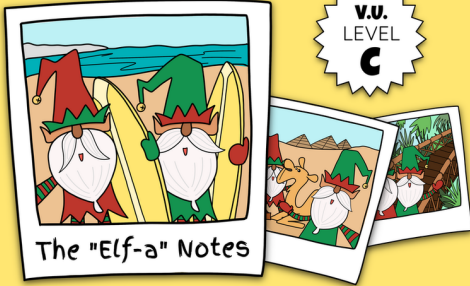

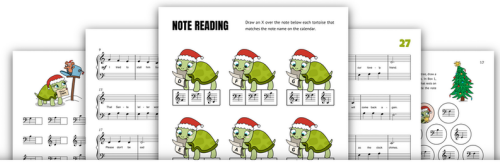

HOW TO PLAY

- 1 To begin, place one penny (turkey) over each colored game square on the game board.
- 2 Next, choose a penny, name the note image underneath, and then slide the penny along the game squares that contain the matching note images. The penny cannot skip over any game squares or move diagonally. For example, if a penny is resting on F on the bass staff, the coin slides from F to F to F...
- 3 Once the penny moves onto a square with a black arrow, it is removed from the game board.
- 4 Repeat Steps 3 and 4 for the remaining pennies on the game board. The game is complete when all pennies are removed.
- 5 **Bonus:** Using pencil crayons that match the colored squares, color each note path.
