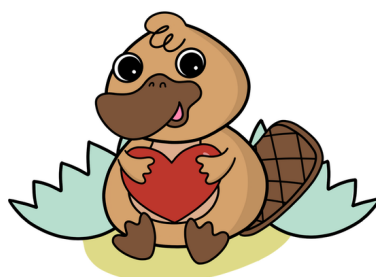

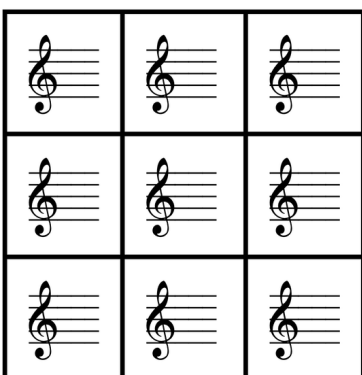

X-O TIC TAC TOE

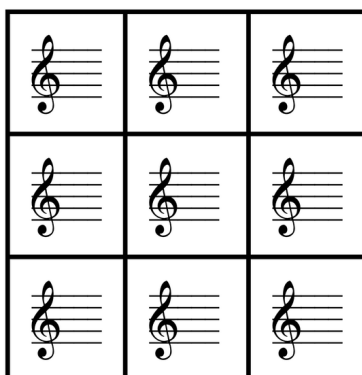

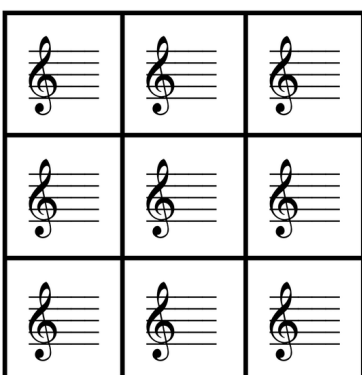
Game 1 - Cs and Ds



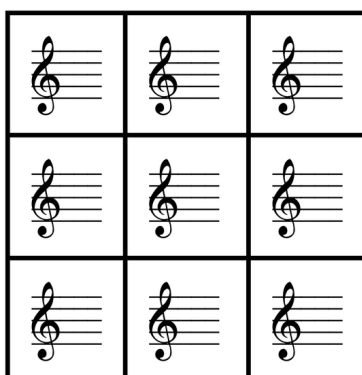
Game 2 - Ds and Es



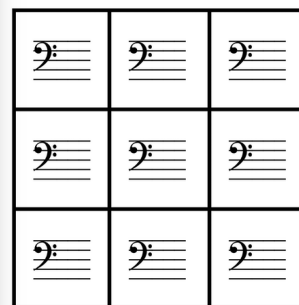
Game 3 - Es and Fs



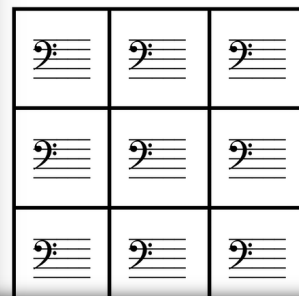

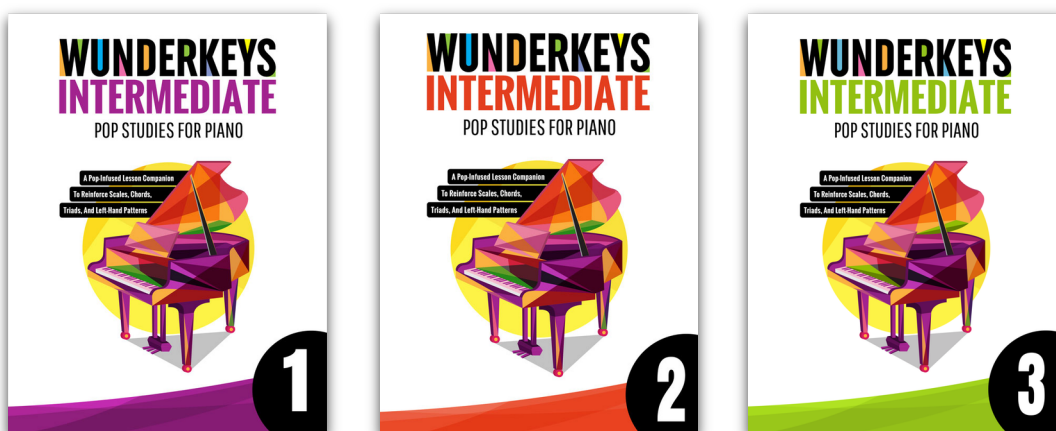

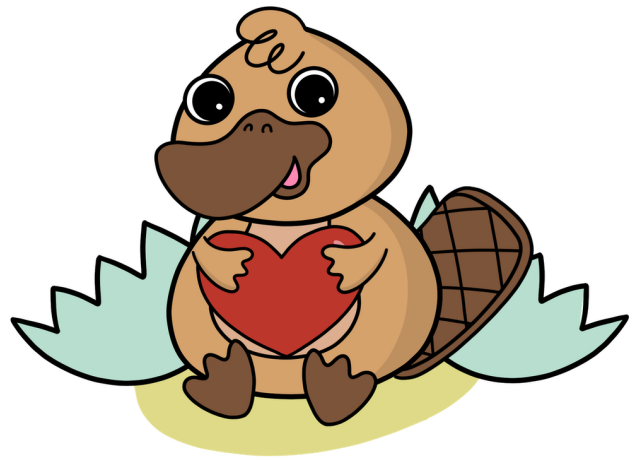

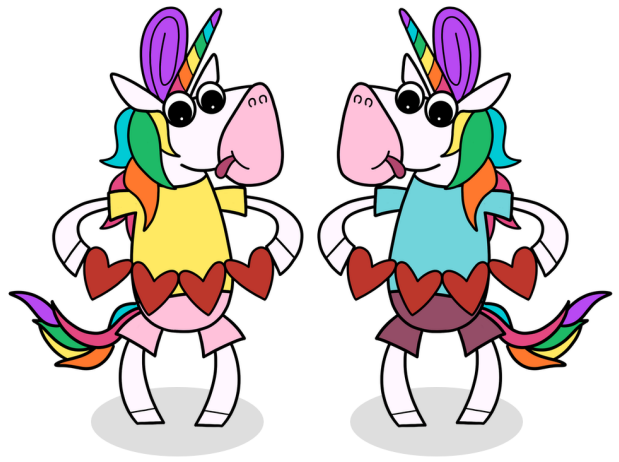
